

COTTON YARN, FABRIC EXPORTS RISE 7% TO \$11.7 BN



THE COUNTRY'S COTTON yarn, fabrics/made-ups and handlooms exports

rose 6.71% year-on-year to \$11.7 billion in 2023-24, even as the total exports dipped by 3% in the last fiscal. According to the commerce ministry data, these exports in March grew by 6.78% to \$1 billion. In 2022-23, these exports stood at \$10.95 billion. This is one of the key product categories out of 30 closely monitored by the ministry.
